- 1 cup white vinegar

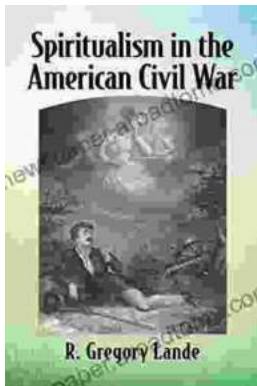
Instructions: Add 1 cup white vinegar to the fabric softener compartment.
